ORDER

Upon consideration of the parties' letters filed pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 28(j), it is

ORDERED that the record in this case be remanded to the district court to allow the district court to determine whether plaintiffs are eligible for interim relief and to take whatever steps are necessary to afford any relief found to be due. In addition, the district court should also determine from the government whether it intends to pursue enforcement of the Proclamation. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that this case be held in abeyance pending further order of the court.

The Clerk is directed to transmit to the district court a copy of this order. The district court is requested to notify this court promptly of its determination. The parties are directed to file motions to govern further proceedings within 7 days of the disposition by the district court, advising whether additional proceedings are necessary in this court or whether the appeal may be dismissed as moot.
