MINUTES of Proceedings: Hearing held before Judge Mustafa T. Kasubhai. Respondents' Response to Plaintiffs' Motion to Enforce Preliminary Injunction ECF Nos. [131], [132] is due 9/11/2026 by 11:59PM. Plaintiffs' Reply is due 9/15/2026 by 5:00PM. No extensions to the briefing schedule will be allowed. **An evidentiary hearing and oral argument on the motion is set for 9/18/2026 at 9:30 AM in a Portland Courtroom 11A before Judge Mustafa T. Kasubhai.** If parties submit declarations or affidavits in support of, or in opposition to, the Motion for Enforcement of Preliminary Injunction, the parties shall ensure the personal appearance of those declarants or affiants for examination at the evidentiary hearing, unless the parties stipulate otherwise. The parties shall jointly submit a witness list with anticipated length of each witness's testimony by 9/15/2026 at 5PM. With regard to the informal discovery dispute letters of 8/31/2026 and 9/1/2026 regarding a Rule 26(f) conference, the Court orders the parties to complete their Rule 26(f) conference by 9/15/2026. The Court further finds and orders as follows with regard to the Rule 26(f) dispute: (1) Plaintiffs are entitled to discovery of the identities of anyone subject to a warrantless arrest since 9/28/2025 and their files, and the parties are ordered to discuss during the Rule 26(f) conference the scope of this discovery and any necessary revisions to the protective order to allow for it; (2) the parties Rule 26(f) conference shall include conferral on the completeness of administrative record and also determine if the administrative record is sufficient to address the issue of implementation of the alleged policy for purposes of the APA claims, and Plaintiffs may file a Motion to Complete the Administrative Record if those issues cannot be resolved; and (3) with respect to Claims 1-6, the Court finds good cause to allow discovery for the reasons stated on the record. Petitioners Motion to Compel, ECF Nos. [120] and [121], is GRANTED IN PART as follows: First---for the reasons stated on the record---assuming without deciding that a law enforcement privilege exists in the Ninth Circuit, the Court finds that it would not apply under the circumstances of this case, was waived, and in any event the concerns regarding disclosure are appropriately addressed by the existing protective order in this case. Respondents are therefore ordered to produce any document redacted or withheld under the law enforcement privilege in an unredacted form within 7 days of this order. Second, with respect to the discrepancy between witness testimony and the Respondents production, Petitioners may serve notices for a Rule 30(b)(6) deposition to

explore Respondents ESI processes and may serve RFPs and interrogatories aimed at any remaining discrepancies. Third, Petitioner may serve notices for a Rule 30(b)(6) deposition on the topic of at-large operations that were performed throughout October and November 2025 in Oregon. Fourth, with respect to the missing data from Agent JB, Respondents are authorized to serve interrogatories and depose any individuals with knowledge of missing documents and data, and any attempts to recover the missing documents and data. Finally, with respect to any redacted personally identifiable information, the following is ordered produced: the names, contact information and narrative descriptions of events of any noncitizens in documents related to events taking place between October 29-31, 2025; and the names of any agents from documents related to that same period.
